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<p>Description of the organization</p>	<p>Founded by the regional council of Île-de-France, the Hubertine Auclert Center is a resource center dedicated to the promotion of gender equality.</p> <p>The main goals of the organization are as follow:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> → Promoting equality between women and men; → Making people aware of the necessity to fight against discrimination based on sex and gender, → Producing expertise in these fields; → Studying and increasing awareness about violence against women. <p>Associated body of the Île-de-France Region, the Hubertine Auclert Center is composed of 113 members: 93 associations, 9 unions and 12 local authorities.</p> <p>Since 2013, the Center has integrated the Regional Observatory on violence against women.</p>

Outline of the project idea	<p>If digital tools improve our daily life and the learning process, abuse contains some risks and might become a source of violence, especially to children and teenagers.</p> <p>We wish to set up a project on cybersexism which primarily affects young girls or lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender teenagers.</p> <p>Cybersexism are cyberviolence of sexist and sexual nature. This kind of violence rest upon stereotypes and injunctions on sexuality, way of dressing, physical appearance, etc...of girls and boys.</p> <p>Therefore, this kind of violence encompasses harassment, insults, blackmail, broadcasting humiliating images via digital networks, identity theft, etc.</p> <p>For this project, we would like to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Make an inventory of all the existing tools among the European countries in order to fight against cybersexism; • Organize an exchange of good practices between several countries via a public event, workshops and the publication of a guide of good practices for schools, local authorities, etc...; • Work on creation of awareness and training tools for students and supervisors; • Develop a new digital tool for mobile devices in order to fight against cybersexism; • Develop via theatrical performances awareness among students on the cybersexism issues.
