Mobility for increased internationalization

Outline of project idea

Kilbergsskolan, a school with appr. 300 pupils, ages of 4-12, in Bollnäs' municipality (north mid Sweden) is interested to develop its staff in order to become a more internationally engaged school. As a start we want to send pre-school teachers, teachers and recreation-/youthleaders to similar kinds of schools in Europe.

The mobility project is the initial stage in making the school more international. A second step would be to start more strategic collaborations with other schools, engaging also pupils. Therefore – hosting a Swedish visit could lead to further collaboration projects.

We would like to send about 15 staff members in smaller groups of 2-3 people to different schools in Europe for duration of 3-5 days.

Themes of interest:

- Teaching maths and sciences
- Inclusion of pupils with learning disabilities or other problems
- Literacy learning (strategies for literacy learning)
- Recreation, what pupils do in and outside school

We are interested in making study visits including job shadowing, meetings and discussions with teachers and other staff, comparing methods etc.
