Municipality:	<p>Køge Municipality is located approximately 40 kilometres south of Copenhagen and has 57.000 citizens. Apart from being an integrated part of Copenhagen, the municipality is rapidly becoming a regional growth centre. The establishment of a new hospital, the development of a new housing area, a new railway and train station, and the business park Scandinavian Transport Centre are some of the projects, which contribute to this development.</p> <p>In 2011 Campus Køge a physical and virtual education cooperation between partners from primary to university level started in Køge. Campus Køge connects education, business and student activities to ensure a higher level of education in order to benefit young people (students), the different educations, the business sector and the cultural sector in the Køge area.</p>
Project idea:	<p>The word Campus usually relates to an area owned by a university with a number of different buildings, college buildings, libraries, student flats etc.</p> <p>The Campus in Køge is different as it is not owned by one organization. There are members representing primary education, secondary education, vocational training, adult education, university colleges and universities. Some of the members are physically located within the Campus area while others are virtual members.</p> <p>Campus Køge is looking for partners in Europe that have established a Campus working in the same manner and with members from different levels of education.</p> <p>The goal of this project is to optimize working in a Campus by focusing on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Organizational structures for a campus involving different levels of education</li><li>- How to optimize synergies between the existing educations</li><li>- How to stimulate students moving from one level of education to the next</li><li>- How to brand an attractive campus</li></ul> <p>Activities will be developed together with interested partners.</p>
