We are responsible for



- Preparing and delivering the Local Transport Plan (LTP) for the West Midlands Metropolitan Area;
- Producing strategies for developing public transport networks;
- Managing and planning local rail services (in partnership with the DfT);
- Improving bus services by working in partnership with private sector operators;
- Planning and funding socially necessary bus routes and complementary travel services such as Ring and Ride;













We are also responsible for

- Operating concessionary travel schemes for over 60's, disabled and young people;
- Investing in new rail and bus stations;
- Developing and promoting new public transport projects such as light rail and bus rapid transit networks;
- Providing pre-paid ticketing and comprehensive public transport information services - including by phone and Internet;
- Managing and maintaining bus interchanges, bus stops and shelters.
